GENERAL INFORMATION: Tomato plants frequently fail to set blossoms early in the season or during cold weather. This undesirable characteristic can be overcome without regard to variety or temperature with Cooke Tomato-Plus. Spraying it on flowers will stimulate the formation of tomatoes. This is of particular value in locations where prevailing conditions interfere with effective pollination.

Point nozzle (see arrow on nozzle) toward plant. Hold container 14 - 16 inches from flower cluster. Spray each cluster a fraction of a second . . . one light, brief press of nozzle.

Apply as a direct fine spray to blossom clusters when the majority of flowers in the clusters are open.

Do not spray individual clusters more than once. Do not apply directly to leaves or fruit. Do not spray leaves or fruit. Do not make more than five applications per season. Spray clusters lightly for best results. Do not use on tomatoes grown for seed. Do not spray flower beds, vegetables or ornamental plantings. Avoid drift of spray vapors as this product may injure nearby susceptible plants. Spray on a calm day.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in original container out of reach of children and domestic animals. Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
