PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if absorbed through skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. 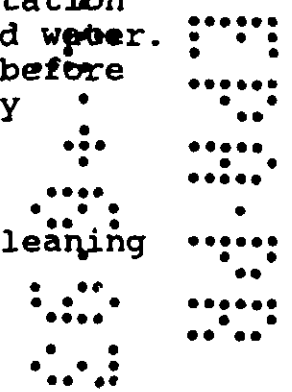
STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention. If In Eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists. If On Skin Or Clothing: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. If Inhaled: Remove affected person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

HOW TO USE

Shake well before using. For spot treatment. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed. Avoid contamination of food or food preparation surfaces.

To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Sowbugs, and Spiders: Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets; and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance.

To Kill Fleas and Ticks: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters; nearby cracks and crevices; along and behind baseboards; window and door frames; and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Pet's old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. **DO NOT SPRAY PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT.** Pets should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product prior to reentering treated premises.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store this product in its original container out of reach of children and domestic animals. Do not reuse container. Rinse container before discarding. Wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
