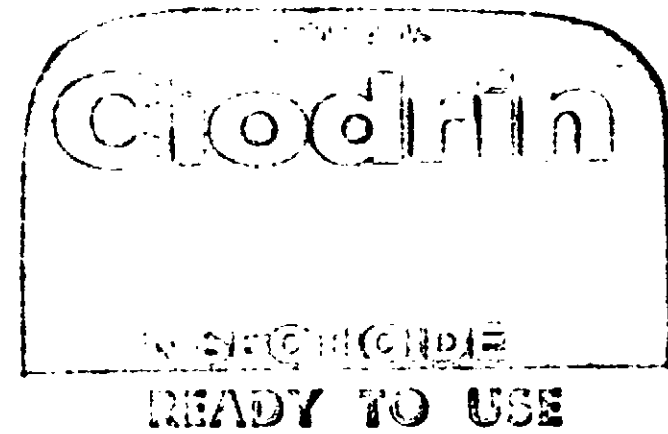

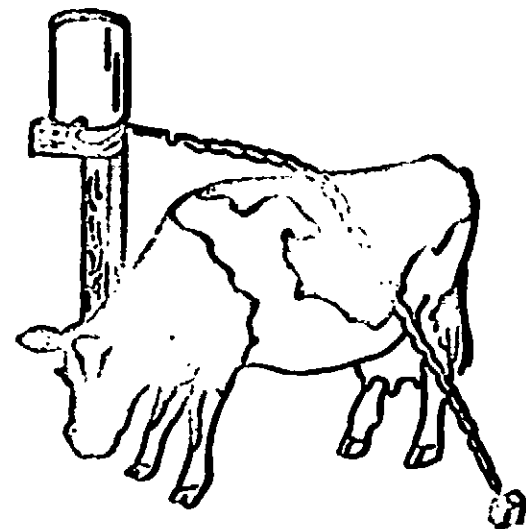

DIRECTIONS

Co-op Backrubber Oil with Ciodrin — is ready-to-use in mechanical backrubbers and on burlap type rubbers. It is carefully formulated with oils soothing to the animals' skin. This oil flows well at temperatures from --10° F, for year-round use.

ON DAIRY AND BEEF CATTLE

For the Control of
 Face Flies and Horn Flies:

Mechanical Backrubbers — For use in all types of livestock oilers. Adjust the valve so that the wick rubber is kept moist and will deliver 1 to 2 fluid ounces of oil per animal. Make an oiler available for each 50 head of cattle.

Burlap Backrubbers — Apply to the burlap at regular intervals, depending on cattle use, weekly or bi-weekly. Use 1 gallon per 20 feet of burlap cable. Treat pieces of burlap with Ciodrin regularly and place them so cattle can rub their faces. This is for protection against face flies.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before smoking or eating. Do not contaminate feed, water or foodstuffs. Keep out of reach of children. If swallowed, induce vomiting immediately and get medical attention.

In case of contact, immediately flush skin or eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes; for eyes, get medical attention.
