






BACIRUBBER OIL WITH 11%

For the Control of
Face Flies and Horn Flies:

Flechanical Backrubbers—For use in all types of livestock oilers. Adjust the valve so that the wick rubber is kept moist and will deliver 1 to 2 fluid ounces of oil per animal. Make an oiler available for each 50 head of cattle.

Burley Backrubbers — Apply to the burlap at regular intervals, depending on cattle use, weekly or bi-westly. Use 1 gallon per 20 feet of burlap cable. Treat pieces of burlap with Ciodrin regularly and place them so cattle can rub their faces. This is for protection against face flies.
