but not more frequently than once every three weeks. To kill flies, mosquitoes and gnats in the barn prior to milking, close all doors and windows and direct the spray toward the ceiling. The barn should remain closed for 10 to 20 minutes. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Repeat as necessary. Ventilate room before re-entry.

To protect livestock from attack by fleas, spray bedding and walls of pen, particularly cracks and crevices. Repeat treatment frequently until adequate control is obtained. *livestock bedding*

We also suggest the use of a residual insecticide, on the walls, such as Cygon or Korlan, and sanitary measures to control fly breeding in and around stables.
