

FOR CONTROLLING MICE

FOR CONTROLLING MICE, use WORLD-WIDE REDI-MIX PELLETS same as for rats, but use smaller quantities (1 teaspoonful to 1 tablespoonful) and place bait stations at 8-12 foot intervals. Mice are more difficult to control than rats and complete control may take longer.

CAUTION: The active ingredients in WORLD-WIDE REDI-MIX PELLETS (Warfarin) is an anti-coagulant chemical which may cause serious hemorrhage in humans, pets, or livestock. If eaten, give a tablespoonful of salt in a glass of warm water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE FOR PHYSICIANS: In case of ingestion of WORLD-WIDE REDI-MIX PELLETS, blood transfusions combined with intravenous injections and oral doses of Vitamin K are indicated as in the case of hemorrhage caused by overdoses of Dicumarol. (Reg.)

IMPORTANT NOTICE — BAITING MUST BE CONTINUOUS UNTIL COMPLETE LACK OF FEEDING IS NOTED. AT LEAST 15 DAYS.

FOR CONTROLLING RATS

PLACE 4 OZS. to 1 LB. of WORLD-WIDE REDI-MIX PELLETS where rats are known to feed or run. Bait should be placed in areas inaccessible to children, pets, wildlife and domestic animals or in tamper proof bait boxes. Pre-baiting is unnecessary.

REPLACE BAIT as consumed. Never use moldy, sour or decomposed baits. Never let a bait station remain empty more than 48 hours.

IMPORTANT NOTICE — BAITING MUST BE CONTINUOUS UNTIL COMPLETE LACK OF FEEDING IS NOTED. USUALLY 10 TO 14 DAYS.

Near dumps and other sources of continual infestation use permanent bait stations and replenish as needed.
