2. Add the phrase, "EPA Registration No. 935-32" and submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
3. Update the "Statement of Practical Treatment" by adding the following:
  - a. If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
  - b. If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.



## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:
