DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use this product only on St. Augustine, Centipede and Zoysia lawns.

1. To control weeds and fertilize the grass, apply anytime the weeds are growing actively at the rate of 5.2 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft.

This will control the following weeds: dandelion, chickweed, oxalis, purslane, bur clover, Florida pusley, black medic, matchweed, cudweed, betony, dollar weed, and dichondra.

A repeat application may be needed, however; wait about 2 months as the results of this product are slow to show.

2. To keep the seeds of crabgrass, spotted spurge, sedge, and paspalum from developing into new plants, apply this product in January, February or March at the rate of 5.2 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. Established weeds of these plants will not be controlled.

This product can be used immediately after sprigging a lawn to reduce weed infestations.

Avoid application on flowers, shrubs and garden plants.

Always apply to dry foliage and wash particles off leaves with a fine mist spray.

Avoid application under trees and shrubs.

Delay sprigging one month and seeding six months after using this product.

ADDITIONAL CAUTIONS

Keep away from feed or food products. Do not take internally. Avoid inhalation or contact with eyes. Wash after handling or using. Do not reuse container. Destroy when empty.

This product contains atrazine at 80% equivalent to 16 lbs. per ton. Apply 13 lbs. per 2500 sq. ft. and according to directions on package.
