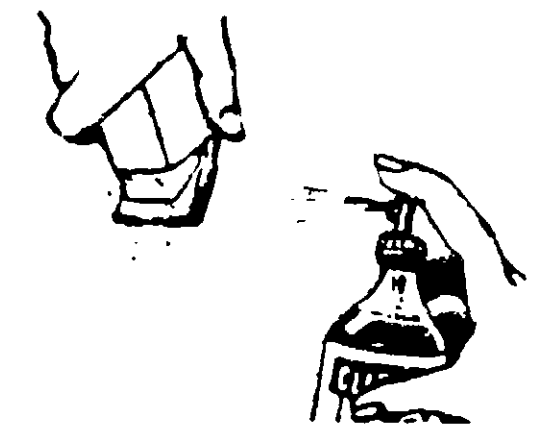

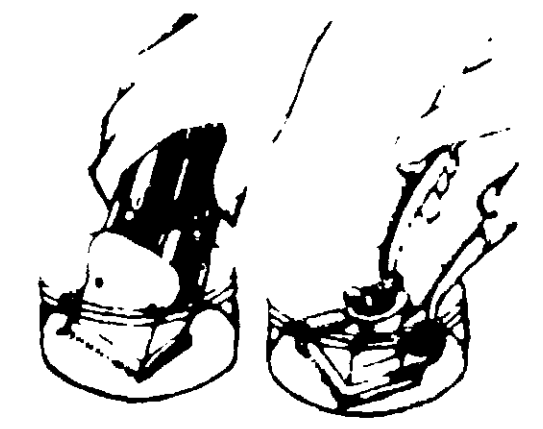

DIRECTIONS

SPRAY: Clipper blades may be sprayed with Clippercide while they are attached to or detached from the clipper. Completely wet blades with spray. If blades are attached to clipper, work clipper blades or run clipper for a moment to insure contact with all surfaces. Allow to drain dry for at least 10 minutes.



DIP: Immerse clipper blades in shallow jar of Clippercide while clipper is running or blades are worked. Remove, shake out excess, and allow to drain for 10 minutes. Detachable blades may be soaked in Clippercide for 10 minutes, removed, and allowed to drain dry.



IMPORTANT: Clippercide should always be kept covered to retard evaporation. Do not spray into open flame.
