DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Mix 1 ounce (30 ml) of SPACIDE with 32 ounces (1 liter) of water. Prepare fresh solution daily or more often if the solution becomes diluted or soiled.

SPACIDE is recommended for use on nail implements, scissors, nippers, brushes, and other inanimate hard, non-porous salon tools, and on whirlpool and pedicure baths, floors, sinks, tables, chairs, basins, tubs, counters and other spa and salon inanimate hard non-porous surfaces and equipment. **TOOLS AND IMPLEMENTS:** Thoroughly clean the above tools and implements prior to complete immersion for 10 minutes at room temperature. Rinse to remove SPACIDE after immersion and dry before use. On the above-mentioned **SURFACES AND EQUIPMENT:** Apply solution prepared as above to pre-cleaned surfaces with a coarse mist pump or trigger sprayer, cloth, mop or sponge so as to wet all surfaces thoroughly. Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes and then let air-dry. Rinse.

CONFIRMATION: When tested with full immersion for 10 minutes at room temperature in a solution prepared as above, SPACIDE was confirmed effective against *Mycobacterium tuberculosis*, *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Salmonella choleraesuis*, *Trichophyton mentagrophytes*, Herpes Simplex Type 1 and Type 2, and Human Immunodeficiency virus Type 1 (HIV-1) AIDS Virus).

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
