HORN FLY AND LOUSE CONTROL

Suspend ZIPCIDE CATTLE DUST BAG in areas frequented by cattle or in gateways or lanes through which the animals pass daily for water, feed or mineral. Dust Bags may also be suspended in halving sheds or in front of protected mineral feeders. For lactating dairy cows, ZIPCIDE Cattle Dust Bag may be suspended in the exit through which cows leave the milking barn. To allow the dust to be adjusted so that the bottom of the bag will hang four to six inches below the bottom of the chute.

INSTALLATION OF ZIPCIDE CATTLE DUST BAG

Suspend the dust bags by inserting rope, chain, or wire through the grommets at the top of the bag and attaching to an overhead structure or by hooking the grommets into hooks fixed to a stationary overhead 2x4 at the heights recommended for horn fly and louse control. Rope, chain or wire can also be tied or attached to two posts or other fixed points with the Dust Bag hanging in the center.

Install as many 10 pound ZIPCIDE Cattle Dust Bags as necessary in lanes or other openings to assure proper dusting of the animals. When dust bags are provided on a free chute basis, allow one 10 pound ZIPCIDE Cattle Dust Bag per 10 to 20 animals. After the bags are in place, pull the rope cord to allow the insecticide to release from the upper bottom.

RESTRICTIONS: Do not hang cattle dust bag over feed, mineral, or water troughs.

CAUTION: Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Do not get in eyes or on skin. Do not breathe dust. Wash thoroughly with soap and warm water after handling.

Do not contaminate food or feed. Keep out of reach of children.

If poisoning occurs obtain prompt medical aid. Prolonged exposure will result in cholinesterase depression.

To Physician: Atropine sulfate is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.
