DIRECTIONS

MISCIBLE SCALE OIL is a "superior type" paraffin base oil, especially refined for use as a dormant and delayed dormant spray on apple, peach, plum, cherry, shade and ornamental trees. It is compounded with wetting, spreading and dispersing agents to assure quick mixing in the tank and thorough wetting on all tree parts. Follow directions of State Extension Men for latest and best use of this material.

FRUIT TREES:

For dormant spraying use 3 gallons Miscible Scale Oil per 100 gallons water. San Jose Scale, Scurfy Scale, Leaf Roller Eggs, and Red Mite Eggs.

NOTE: Oil spray should not be applied when temperature is to fall below freezing before spray has a chance to dry. Do not use where sulphur residue is present.

For delayed dormant spr (when buds are beginning to show green tips) use 2 gallons Miscible Scale Oil per 100 gallons of water. San Jose Scale, Scurfy Scale, Leaf Roller Eggs, and Red Mite Eggs.
