

Read all directions carefully before applying

WHEN TO APPLY: Crabgrass and other weeds are most susceptible during the growing season. However, they are most susceptible during periods of rapid growth. For best results, apply when the weeds are in the early stages of growth. Apply before the weeds are well established and before they have set seed.

CRABGRASS AND GENERAL WEED CONTROL: Two applications are required. The first application is made when the weeds are in the early stages of growth. The second application is made when the weeds are in the late stages of growth. This is particularly important for crabgrass, which is a perennial weed and can regrow from its roots.

HOW TO APPLY: For best results, apply by hand or with a backpack sprayer. Walk through the weeds and spray them thoroughly. Do not spray the weeds from a distance, as this will result in poor coverage.

BROADLEAF WEED CONTROL: Apply when the weeds are in the early stages of growth. This is particularly important for broadleaf weeds, which are most susceptible during this period.

HOW TO APPLY: For best results, apply by hand or with a backpack sprayer. Walk through the weeds and spray them thoroughly. Do not spray the weeds from a distance, as this will result in poor coverage.

IMPORTANT: Do not apply to lawns, gardens, or other areas where desirable plants are growing. Do not apply to areas where children or pets may be present. Do not apply to areas where water may be present, as this will result in pollution. Do not apply to areas where wind may be present, as this will result in drift.

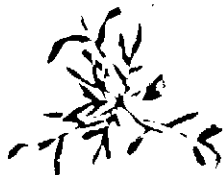
