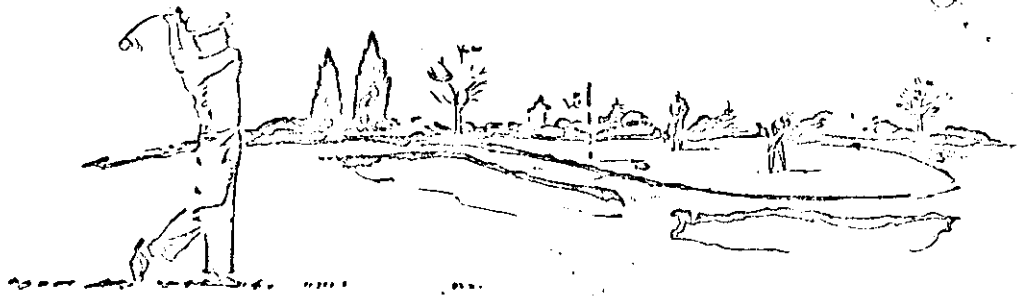

Apply GREENSKEEPER CHINCH BUG CONTROL uniformly over the turf area at rate of 1 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. Make the first treatment when insects first appear and re-treat as needed. Keep children and pet. off treated area until material is washed into the soil with 30 gallons of water per 1,000 sq. ft. and grass is dry.

To control Hyperodas (Turfgrass) Weevils, use twice the rate of GREENSKEEPER CHINCH BUG CONTROL indicated for other insects that suspected problem areas in mid-April and again in mid-May. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service specialist for the best time to treat in your area.

For control of larvae of Japanese Beetle and European Chaffer, apply at the rate of 2 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. Follow with adequate sprinkling to wash material into turf. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service for the best time to treat in your area.

WARNING
