WHAT PREEN DOES

Preen keeps out most weeds from shrubs, trees, and listed flowers and vegetables practically all season long. You'll have clean-looking flower beds, garden areas and shrubs without difficult hand weeding. Preen doesn't kill weeds; it prevents them as the weed seeds germinate. And without weeds to compete with, your plants can grow larger, stronger and healthier. With transplants, you can apply to the soil anytime before planting.

PREEN IS RECOMMENDED FOR THESE ESTABLISHED FLOWERS

Achillea, Ageratum, Arctotis, Aster, Balsam, Calendula, Centaurea, California Poppy, Calliopsis, Carnation, Chrysanthemum, Cosmos, Dahlia, Dianthus, Dimorphaea, Forget-me-not, Four O'Clock, Gaillardia, Gladiolus (more than 1" in diameter), Hollyhock, Ixora, (Coccinea), Lobelia, Lupines, Marigold, Morning Glory, Nasturtium, Nicotiana, Periwinkle, Petunia, Phlox, Portulaca, Rudbeckia, Salvia, Scabiosa, Shasta Daisy, Snapdragon, Stocks, Snow on the Mountain, Sunflower, Sweet Alyssum, Sweet Pea, Sweet William, Zinnia.

PREEN IS RECOMMENDED FOR THESE VEGETABLES AS DIRECTED

From Seed: Carrots, Okra, Southern Peas (Cow Peas), Field Peas, Black-eyed Peas, Lima Beans, Snap Beans.

Before Transplanting

Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Peppers, Tomatoes.

After Transplanting

Irish Potatoes.

SHRUBS AND TREES

Use Preen around most common varieties to prevent weeds throughout the growing season.

WHEN TO APPLY

Apply Preen as early as possible in the growing season to take advantage of the season-long weed control it provides. Or you can apply Preen anytime of the year around shrubs, trees and established plants. May be applied up to 10 weeks before planting most seeded vegetables.

HOW TO APPLY

Since Preen doesn't kill weeds but prevents them, you must first remove existing weeds.

Preen is not recommended on muck soils.



Established Plants

Flowers, ornamental plants, trees and listed vegetables at least 2-3" tall. Sprinkle like salt on soil surface, using enough to match this picture. This equals 1 oz. per 10 sq. ft.



Before Planting

Use only on 2-3" listed flower and vegetable transplants. Do not use with flower seed. Sprinkle Preen as shown on medium loam soil and mix in. This equals 1 lb. per 960 sq. ft. For light or heavy loam, see chart below. Mix into soil with rake or rototiller 1-3" deep. Then place transplant. Do not apply after transplanting. May be applied up to 10 weeks before planting vegetable seeds.

A Word of Caution

Use with transplants listed, but never use when planting seed except for the vegetables listed above. May be used when plants from seed are 2-3" tall. Do not apply to ground cover or flowers from cuttings other than those listed. Preen is not intended for use on lawns. Preen may be applied annually whenever you spray control weeds. Rain does not wash Preen out of the soil. Should not be used in enclosed areas such as greenhouses. Should not be used in areas where it will be applied to the soil before the plants are established.
