One application in Spring stops crabgrass before it starts. This product will not damage established bluegrass, ryegrass, fescue, zoysiagrass, Bermudagrass, St. Augustinegrass and centipedegrass turfs when applied as directed. Do not apply to new grass planted the previous Fall. Do not apply to bentgrass or dichondra, nor to newly-sprigged areas of Bermudagrass, St. Augustinegrass or centipedegrass.

WHEN TO APPLY

Apply this product in the spring **before crabgrass germinates**. If you plan to re-seed, wait 6 weeks after application. The fertilizer in this product may thicken grass enough to reduce or eliminate re-seeding.

HOW TO APPLY

For best crabgrass control, this product must be applied evenly over your lawn without skips or misses. Determine the correct amount for your lawn area. Do not over-apply or under-apply. Apply the contents of one bag for every 5,000 sq. ft. of lawn area (for example 50 ft. x 100 ft. = 5,000 sq. ft.). If your lawn measures 100 ft. x 100 ft. (or 10,000 sq. ft.), 2 bags are sufficient.

1. Using the Recommended Setting below (calculated to apply at one-half rate), spread one-half of the required amount for your lawn, moving at a steady rate in one direction.
2. Spread the other half of the required amount over the same area moving across or at right angles to the first application. This minimizes skips and overlaps, insuring good coverage. When turning or stopping spreader, close spreader gate.
3. Where this two-step procedure is not practical, apply this product in one trip over the lawn using the One-Step settings listed below. Be careful to cover lawn completely, since crabgrass can grow in spots which are missed.
