





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APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Rake the lawn to remove leaves and other debris.
2. **On Established Lawns:** Apply at the rate of 5 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. (12 1/2 lb. bag covers 2,500 sq. ft.). Apply after the 1st or 2nd mowing (usually at the time forsythia blossoms start to fall) in the Spring before crabgrass and other annual grass weeds emerge.
3. **On Newly-Seeded Areas:** Apply at the rate of 2 1/2 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. (12 1/2 lb. bag covers 5,000 sq. ft.). Apply immediately after seeding in early Spring before crabgrass and other annual weeds emerge.




