estrictions on Retreatment: Do not apply more than 2 broadcast applications per year per treatment site on residential, commercial and recreational turf. not apply more than 4 broadcast applications per year per treatment site on commercial sod.

Do not apply more than 174 lbs. per acre (4 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.) of Lebanon Fertilizer Plus Confront*TR Brand Herbicide at one time.

For ground application only.

TURF

Broadcast Treatment of Residential, Commercial, and Recreational Turf and Commercial Sod

Apply 87 to 174 lbs. per acre (2 to 4 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.) of Lebanon Fertilizer Plus Confront*TR Brand Herbicide granules to control broadleaf weeds growing in tall fescue, bluegrass, or perennial ryegrass turf. **Do not** use on other grass species, such as bentgrass or St. Augusting grass, unless injury can be tolerated. Lebanon Fertilizer Plus Confront*TR Brand Herbicide granules at 130 lbs. per acre (3 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.) will provide control of most weeds listed. The use of 174 lbs. per acre (4 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.) is suggested for those weeds listed above followed by an (a). Optimum control, of those weeds listed above followed by a (b), has been obtained when two applications of 130 lbs. per acre (3 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.) have been made 4 weeks apart. Apply from early spring through early fall when weeds are growing. Applications should be made 4 weeks apart to minimize grass injury.

Spot Treatment of Residential, Commercial, and Recreational Turf and Commercial Sod

Apply 87 to 174 lbs. per acre (2 to 4 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.) of Lebanon Fertilizer Plus Confront*TR Brand Herbicide to target areas preferably when foliage of target weeds is moist from rainfall or irrigation.

Newly seeded turf should be moved two or three times before being treated. If soil conditions are dry, water turf prior to application. Do not water turf for 24 hours after application. Do not reseed for 3 weeks after application.

Application Instructions:

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For best results, apply this product evenly and uniformly over the turfgrass area, avoiding streaking, skips or overlaps. Before each application, calibrate the spreader according to the equipment manufacturer's directions. Adjust the spreader so the spreader delivers the appropriate application rate as recommended above.

Restrictions for Broadcast Application on Commercial Sod: A maximum of 174 lbs. per acre (4 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.) of Lebanon Fertilizer Plus Confront*TR Brand Herbicide may be applied up to four times a year to control a variety of broadleaf weed species which may germinate at different periods.

This product contains the secondary nutrient iron. Iron may stain concrete and should not be applied on dry or water dampened concrete and should be moved from these areas promptly after application by sweeping or blowing. Do not wash off with water.
