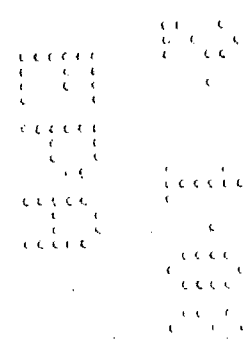
Broadcast Treatment of Residential, Commercial, and Recreational Turf and Commercial Sod

Apply 87 to 174 lbs. per acre (2 to 4 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.) of Lebanon Fertilizer Plus Confront® TR Brand Herbicide granules to control broadleaf weeds growing in tall fescue, bluegrass, or perennial ryegrass turf. **Do not** use on other grass species, such as bentgrass or St. Augustine grass, unless injury can be tolerated. Lebanon Fertilizer Plus Confront® TR Brand Herbicide granules at 130 lbs. per acre (3 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.) will provide control of most weeds listed. The use of 174 lbs. per acre (4 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.) is suggested for those weeds listed above followed by an (a). Optimum control, of those weeds listed above followed by a (b), has been obtained when two applications of 130 lbs. per acre (3 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.) have been made 4 weeks apart. Restrictions for Broadcast Application on Residential, Commercial, and Recreational Turf: A maximum of 174 lbs. per acre (4 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.) of Lebanon Fertilizer Plus Confront® TR Brand Herbicide may be applied two times per year.
