4. Per the 2,4-D RED label table, the text in **bold type** below must be added to the following User Safety Requirements:

“...If no such instructions for washables **exist**, use detergent and hot water...”

5. Per the 2,4-D RED, the text below in bold type must be added to the User Safety Recommendations currently on the label:

“User Safety Recommendations

User should wash hands before, eating, drinking, chewing gum, tobacco, or using the toilet.

User should remove clothing/PPE immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing.

Users should remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing.”

6. Per the 2,4-D RED, the Environmental Hazards text currently on the label must be revised to read:

“This pesticide may be toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates. The text “Do not enter or allow others to enter the treated area until dusts have settled” must remain in this section of the label.

9. The following revisions are needed to the Directions for Use:

For sod farm use:

Per the 2,4-D RED, the text "Do not apply more than 4 broadcast applications per year per treatment site on commercial sod" must be revised to read "Limited to 2 applications per year" and any conflicting text must be deleted from the label.

Per the 2,4-D RED, a 21-day retreatment interval must be added to use restrictions for treatment of sod.

10. Add the following statement to the labeling:

Broadcast Treatment of Residential, Commercial, and Recreational Turf and Commercial Sod

Apply 87 to 174 lbs. per acre (2 to 4 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.) of Lebanon Fertilizer Plus Confront® TR Brand Herbicide granules to control broadleaf weeds growing in tall fescue, bluegrass, or perennial ryegrass turf. **Do not** use on other grass species, such as bentgrass or St. Augustine grass, unless injury can be tolerated. Lebanon Fertilizer Plus Confront® TR Brand Herbicide granules at 130 lbs. per acre (3 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.) will provide control of most weeds listed. The use of 174 lbs. per acre (4 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.) is suggested for those weeds listed above followed by an (a). Optimum control, of those weeds listed above followed by a (b), has been obtained when two applications of 130 lbs. per acre (3 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.) have been made 4 weeks apart. Apply from early spring through early fall when weeds are growing. Applications should be made 4 weeks apart to minimize grass injury.

Spot Treatment of Residential, Commercial, and Recreational Turf and Commercial Sod

Apply 87 to 174 lbs. per acre (2 to 4 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.) of Lebanon Fertilizer Plus Confront® TR Brand Herbicide to target areas preferably when foliage of target weeds is moist from rainfall or irrigation.

Newly seeded turf should be mowed two or three times before being treated. If soil conditions are dry, water turf prior to application. Do not water turf for 24 hours after application. Do not reseed for 3 weeks after application.

Application Instructions:

For best results, apply this product evenly and uniformly over the turfgrass area, avoiding streaking, skips or clumps. Before each application, calibrate the spreader according to the equipment manufacturer's directions. Adjust the spreader so the spreader delivers the appropriate application rate as recommended above.

Restrictions for Broadcast Application on Residential, Commercial, and Recreational Turf: A maximum of 174 lbs. per acre (4 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.) of Lebanon Fertilizer Plus Confront® TR Brand Herbicide may be applied two times per year.

Restrictions for Broadcast Application on Commercial Sod: A maximum of 174 lbs. per acre (4 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.) of Lebanon Fertilizer Plus Confront® TR Brand Herbicide may be applied up to four times a year to control a variety of broadleaf weed species which may germinate at different periods.
