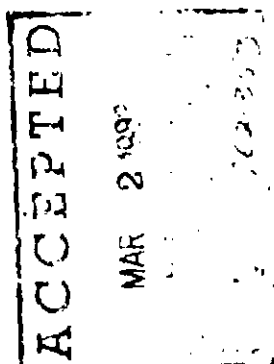

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR

LACCO COPPER NAPHTHENATE SOLUTION 2 is prepared to meet Bureau of Ships Specification No. MIL-W-18142B, dated August 13, 1957, and is recommended for the treatment of wood, canvas, burlap, rope, wood for greenhouses, i.e., nursery flats, and nets to protect against termites, dry rot, molds and other destroying or staining fungi. This product is not a stain. Color is from fungicide only and is not colorfast.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR CANVAS, BURLAP, ROPES, NETS, WOOD FOR GREENHOUSES, I.E., NURSERY FLATS :

Dilute with an equal volume of petroleum paint thinner or similar petroleum solvent; brush, spray or dip the material to be treated until thoroughly wet.

WOOD: Fence posts, poles, foundation timbers and heavy wooden members should be free of bark, dry and well-seasoned and immersed in the undiluted product for a period of 12 to 48 hours to be an effective wood preserver. Wood intended to be in contact with the soil should be dipped for a minimum of 3 minutes or if treated by the brush or spray method, receive two or more flowing coats of the product.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

WARNING
