HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Danger. Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. May be fatal if swallowed. Irritating to nose and throat. Avoid breathing of vapor. Do not get into eyes or skin or on clothing. ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters unless in accordance with a NPDES permit. For guidance, contact your Regional Office of the EPA. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of container and equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING: (For large containers, lay container on its side and roll back and forth several times, then pour out as usual.)

FOR GENERAL CLEANING AND DEODORIZING OTHER THAN IN EDIBLE PRODUCT PROCESSING AREAS: Use one part this product to 40 parts of water for spraying or hand washing non-porous surfaces such as walls, ceilings, floors and plumbing fixtures. Allow to stand for 10 minutes, then rinse with potable water.

FOR CLEANING AND DEODORIZING DRAIN GRATINGS: Dilute 1 to 2 cups of this product with 1 gallon of water and use this solution, with scrubbing to clean the top and bottom sides of all drain gratings in the kill floor, fabrication and other working areas. Pour the excess down the drain. Allow to stand for 10 minutes before rinsing with potable water. This product will clean drain lines and grease traps as it stands overnight enroute to the sewer.

TO CLEAN AND REDUCE ODORS IN SEWER LINES, CHEMICAL TOILET TANKS, CESSPOOLS, AND SEPTIC TANKS AND PRIVIES:

Sewer Lines: Use this product undiluted 1 to 25 gallons depending upon the size of the sewer line. Allow to remain 12 hours or more. Flush with hot water.

SEPTIC TANKS: Use 1 cup of this product per week applied through kitchen sink, basin or toilet bowls.

PRIVIES: To control odors and aid in sanitary disposal, first mix this product with an equal amount of water, and pour into pit. Repeat this treatment as necessary to control disagreeable odors and other nuisances.

CESSPOOLS: Use 1 quart of this product once every three months by pouring down wash basin and toilet drains.

CHEMICALS TOILET TANKS:

1. This product should be used alone since other chemicals are not necessary or may actually interfere with the results, we suggest that when using this product for the first time that the tank be emptied and flushed thoroughly before charging.
2. Place the required amount of water for the initial charge in the tank according to the following chart. Then mix proper amounts of this product with a small amount of water, and add to the water in the tank. Agitate thoroughly.

3. For best results and continued effectiveness, maintain proportions by weekly addition of $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of this product in a quart of water. For multiple units add similar amounts for each additional toilet bowl or urinal. Agitate vigorously each time this product is added.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or food by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Keep product in a tightly closed container when not in use. Keep from freezing. Do not reuse empty container.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide spray mixture, or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to Federal or approved state procedures under Subtitle C of the Resources Conservation and Recovery Act.
