This revision indicates that the user may use it in home and apartment but only in the non food areas of the remaining sites. c. Insert "(outdoor)" immediately after the term "Cans" on the front panel labeling claim. d. f. Insert as the first sentence of the "If swallowed" STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: "Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately."; delete "Call a physician immediately." where it appears later on in this paragraph.

g. Change the heading "DISPOSAL" to "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" and insert the following as the first line of this section:

"Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal."

h. Under "OUTDOORS: Ants, Chiggers, Fleas" change "insections" to "insects".

i. As discussed via telephone, since this is to be a homeowner as well as commercial/industrial product, delete "in a good machine adjusted to deliver a coarse low pressure spray." (in the Brown Dog Tick directions) since the homeowner is not expected to own such a machine.

j. As discussed via telephone this product employs the use of a pump sprayer; the directions for using this device should appear on the label.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA Sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
