USE IN NON-FOOD AREAS OF INSTITUTIONS, RESTAURANTS, FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS, AND IN AND AROUND HOMES: Including garbage rooms, lavatories, linen closets (linen closets), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, trap closets and storage (after canning or bottling). Apply as a spot treatment to baseboard areas, around water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, beneath tables, poles and similar areas where insects hide or through which they may enter. To Kill: Carpet Beetles, Cigarette Beetles, Clothes Moths: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to the edges of, and under, carpets and rugs, floors, wall baseboards and spray cracks, crevices, closets and infested areas of clothing. Repeat treatment if infestation occurs.

To Kill: Flies, Mosquitoes, Fruit Flies, Gnats, Small Flying Moths: Use only on outdoor surfaces. Spray outside surfaces of awnings, porches, eaves and other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas, such as under eaves, porches, gutters and in garages where these insects may roost. Apply flies and mosquitoes coming in rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when effective business diminishes.

To Kill: Outdoors: Ants, Chiggers, Fleas: For treatment of localized infestations of these insects in outdoor areas, spray weeds and nearby nesting areas around the home or buildings thoroughly. Avoid spraying desirable plants. For ants, thoroughly wet trails and runways. Repeat application as infestation occurs.

To Kill: Brown Dog Ticks: For rapid clearance of brown dog ticks in refuges and in kennels, kennels or where infestation occurs, apply as a spot treatment. Apply with special attention to cracks and crevices and other insect hiding places. Fresh water should be provided for animals after treatment. Do not treat animals. Repeat treatment as necessary.

Subject: Amendment - Change Product Name and Minor Text Revisions
Caticide Crack and Crevice Spray
EPA Registration No. 991-32
Your Application Dated February 17, 1983

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided the following revisions are incorporated prior to release for shipment under the amended labeling:

1. Revise "Fleas, Outdoor Crickets" in the top front panel claims to read "Fleas (Outdoors), Crickets." There was evidently a misunderstanding over which pest the "outdoors" accompanied as requested in the Notice of Registration and our letter of December 6, 1982.
2. Add DIAZINON in front of the formula name for that chemical in the ingredients statement. Note that the formula name should then have brackets placed at the beginning and end.
3. Relocate "KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN" above "CAUTION" and delete "harmful if swallowed" from this front panel section.
4. "Harmful if swallowed" should appear as the first sentence of the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section directly under that section's "CAUTION."

Please submit five (5) copies of the revised label prior to release for shipment under the amended product name labeling.

The registration record for the product has been amended to show the change in product name to "CATIC Crack and Crevice Bug Control."
