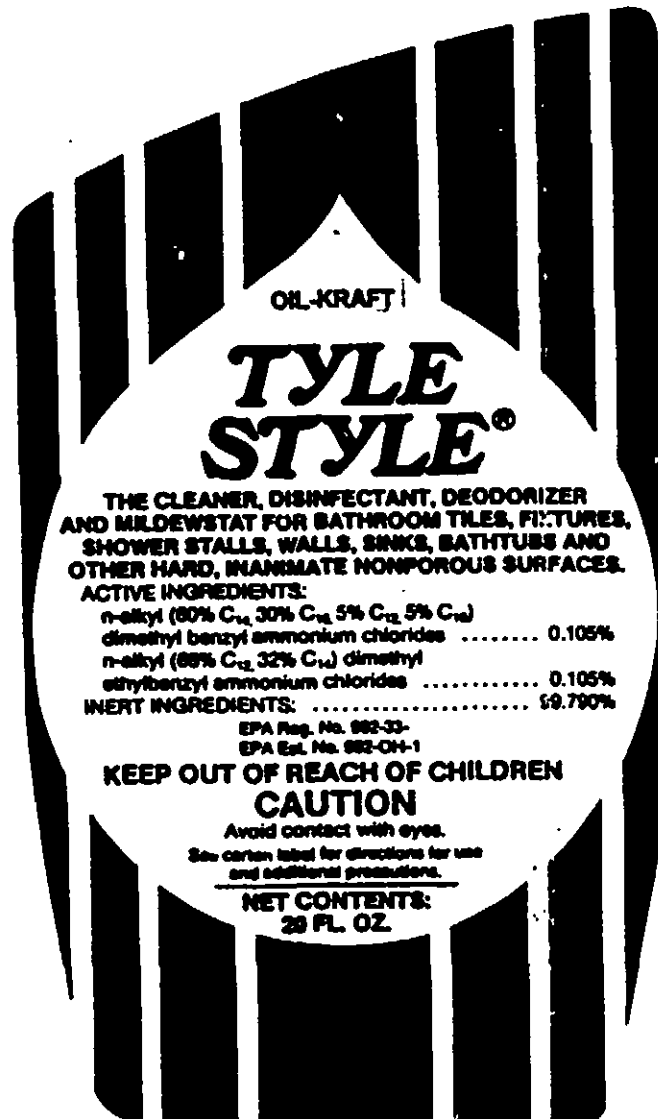

TYLE STYLE[®] DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Tyle Style has been designed specifically for household and institutional cleaning and disinfecting in homes, nursing homes, hospitals, offices, schools, motels and hotels.

DISINFECTION, CLEANING, AND DEODORIZING: To disinfect, clean, and deodorize hard nonporous surfaces such as bathroom tiles, fixtures, shower stalls, walls, sinks and bathtubs, proceed as indicated below:

1. Hold container six to eight inches from surface to be treated.
2. Spray area until it is covered with the solution. Allow the product to penetrate and remain wet for 10 minutes. No scrubbing necessary.
3. Wipe off with a clean cloth, mop or sponge. The product will not leave grit or soap scum.

For heavily soiled areas, remove gross soil before treatment.

MILDEWSTAT: To control mold and mildew on hard nonporous surfaces (such as floors, walls, table tops), spray the surfaces to be treated, making sure to wet completely. Let air dry. Repeat application at weekly intervals or when mildew growth reappears.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

STORAGE: Store in dry place no less than 35° F and no higher than 120° F.

DISPOSAL: Products and container — bottle may only be refilled with Tyle Style from larger container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
