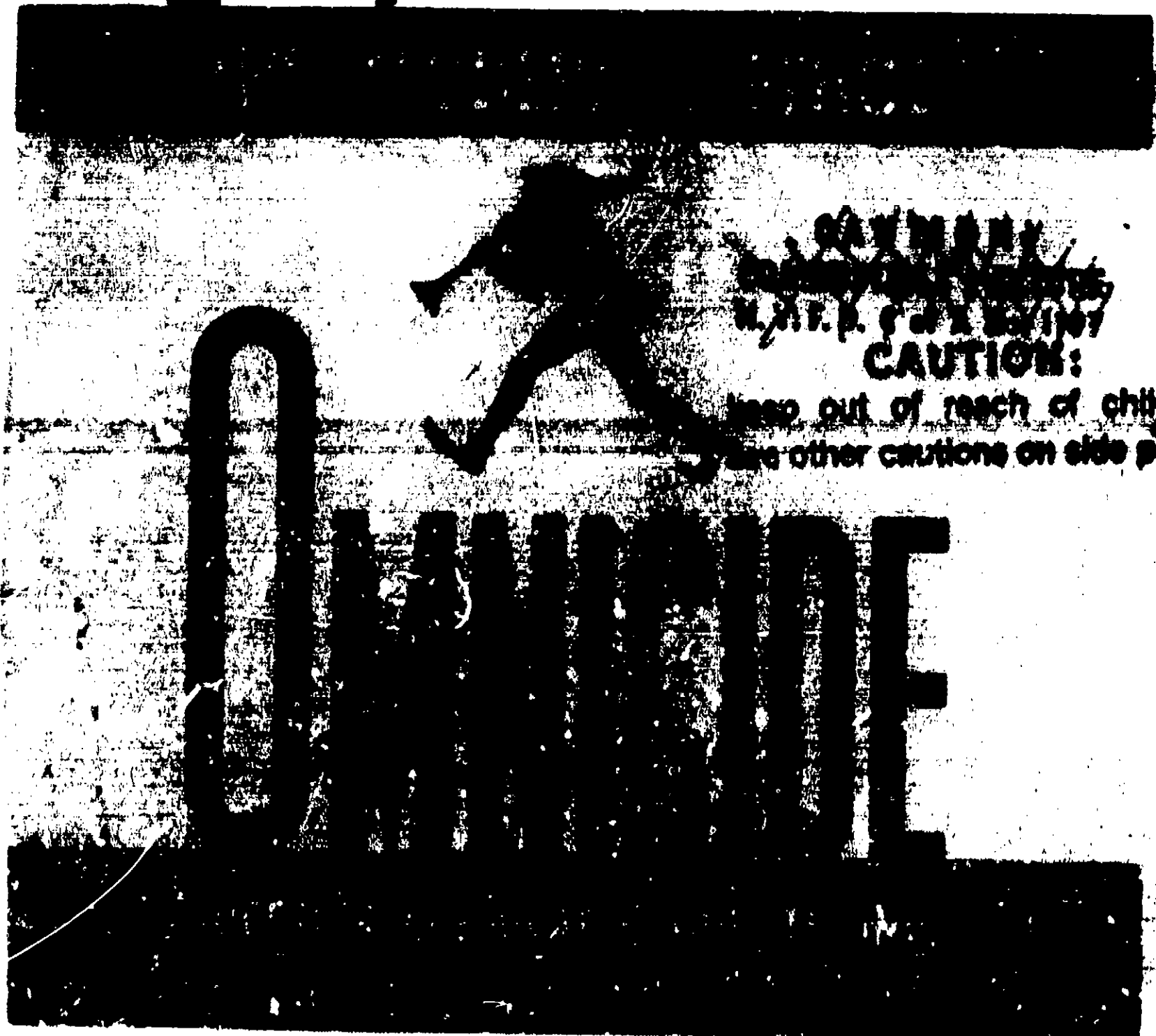

CAUTION: OMNICIDE, while deadly to insects, is non-toxic to humans and warm-blooded animals when used as directed. It is practically odorless, tasteless and harmless and will not harm walls, furniture, upholstery, fabrics and clothing. If articles are wet, exposure to the sunlight will remove any stain.

OMNICIDE can be sprayed directly on warm-blooded animals such as horses, cows, dogs, laboratory animals, etc. Avoid wetting the fur of cats, which are sensitive to all sprays.

FOR TICKS, LICE, FLEAS, follow general directions, and also spray animal bedding, floors, and coverings especially in animal quarters. Spray on mats, light, or for long-haired dogs, washes flaps with OMNICIDE and rub under the fur.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children.

GENERAL DIRECTIONS:

For the best treatment with OMNICIDE, thoroughly spray all cracks, corners, cavities, pipelines, door and windowsills, around plumbing fixtures, damp areas and other possible breeding places. Repeat daily or weekly until no new insects appear, then use about once a month to avoid recurrence.

FOR ROACHES, WATERBUGS, BEETLES AND ANTS, follow general directions.

FOR MOSQUITOES, follow general directions, spray thoroughly the bedsteads, springs and mattresses and the bedroom, including the closets.

CLOTHES MOTHS AND CARPET BEETLES—spray so that vapor reaches every spot breeding these insects. Hang clothes loosely in closets, preferably inside out, so that the vapors reach all seams and folds, where moths might breed. For rugs, raise corner and direct spray under carpet forcing vapors through fabric if possible. Avoid wetting. Treatment should be repeated about once a month unless articles are stored in moth tight containers.

FOR FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS AND SIMILAR FLYING INSECTS, close windows and spray OMNICIDE until air appears foggy. Keep windows and doors closed for about 10 minutes.
