Apply bait lightly to floors near baseboards, in closets, under sinks and refrigerators and in other areas where insects may hide but which are inaccessible to children such as cracks and crevices. Do not apply to animals. Do not treat portions of buildings where animals can feed on bait. Use approximately 4 ounces of bait per 1,000 sq. ft. of space and scatter lightly so that bait is barely visible. Repeat as necessary. Keep out of reach of children.
