GENERAL DIRECTIONS

ONE OUNCE SANIWASH PER GALLON OF WATER WILL GIVE 20-PPM AVAILABLE QUATERNARY AMMONIUM COMPOUND. This concentration will meet most city, state and government sanitation requirements for all types of public eating places. For cleaning and deodorizing heavy soiled table strength or 2 oz. per gallon.

When heavy suds are required, put Saniwash into tank, tub and add hot or cold water under as much pressure as possible.

For DISHES, GLASSWARE, LIGHT CLEANING, walls, floors, toilets, shower stalls, etc., use 1 oz. per gallon of water. RINSING IS NECESSARY ON SURFACES THAT DIRECTLY TOUCH FOODS, SUCH AS EATING OR COOKING UTENSILS AND FOOD CONTAINERS.

STABLES AND KENNELS

Remove dirt and sweat accumulations and other unsightly growths found under saddle pads, etc., with Saniwash per gallon of warm water. Wash horse goods with saddle soap or bath soap as usual after use to avoid drying. Saniwash may be used for washing blankets, horse sheets, rubbers, etc. Will keep them soft and off to touch.

For cleaning and deodorizing animal enclosures, use Saniwash per gallon. Allow Saniwash to remain a few minutes before removing.

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GENERAL DIRECTIONS

SUPERMARKETS

For GENERAL CLEANING and removing blood, fats, wastes, etc., from porcelain, glass, chrome, steel, marble, etc., on counters, refrigerators, appliances and various utensils, use 1 oz. per gallon of warm or cold water.

For CLEANING PARTS OF ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES such as saws and grinders, allow parts to soak a few minutes then wash off.

For CLEANING AND DEODORIZING PRODUCE COUNTERS, where fragments of vegetables and fruits collect and produce bad odors, wash down all the racks, drains and gutters as well as the counters.

For DAIRY CASES, wash down and slush the bottoms of cases which will also eliminate wire brushing, as well as the glass, porcelain and chrome parts.

For FISH AND MEAT CASES, allow Saniwash solution to remain on the drains and floors for a few extra minutes before rinsing.

For FABRICS, such as drapes, curtains, etc., Saniwash is undecoloring. Use only cloth or sponge. Rinse thoroughly. On color fast fabrics, Saniwash will not stain.
