SUPERIOR B-GONE

For resistant Roaches, Waterbugs, Crickets, Ants, Brown Dog Ticks, Millipedes, Spiders, Silverfish, and similar crawling insects.

DIRECTIONS:

INDOORS: For Roaches, Waterbugs, Ants, Crickets, Spiders, Ticks, Silverfish and similar insects. Apply as a course, wet spray to baseboards, window and door sills, underside of shelves and drawers, under sinks, stoves, refrigerators and all cracks and crevices where insects hide and on surfaces over which they crawl. For Ants, spray trails and places where they enter. For Brown Dog Ticks, also treat sleeping quarters of animals and replace with fresh bedding after the spraying. Repeat as necessary.

OUTDOORS: For Ants, Crickets, Millipedes, Brown Dog Ticks, apply as a wet spray or by brush to the surfaces of buildings, porches, screens, window frames, patios and such places as insects congregate. For Ants, spray anthills and runways. Do not spray vegetation. Repeat as necessary.

CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Do not spray foodstuffs, utensils or food preparation areas. Do not spray house plants. Provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Do not apply to animals or humans. May be fatal if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist, avoid contact with skin or eyes. In case of contact, wash with soap and water. Do not allow children to touch treated surfaces while wet. In case of poisoning, obtain prompt medical aid.
