DIRECTIONS:

For use in restaurants, food processing plants, industrial plants, and warehouses. Kills exposed stages of following insects: ROACHES, FLIES, SILVERFISH, WEEVILS, FLYING MOTHS. Spray upwards 6 - 7 oz per 1000 sq. ft. of room space. 2 oz will treat 1000 sq. ft. Close windows for about 15 minutes after treatment. Occupants should vacate before indoor treatments and should not reoccupy the premises until they have been ventilated. After application, open several windows or doors to create air currents to insure reduction of Quick-Tox insecticide vapors. During fogging or mists spray indoors, use a mask or respirator of a type passed by the U.S. Department of Agriculture for DDVP (Vapona Insecticide) protection. For the control of roaches, silverfish, and exposed weevils, treat infested areas around baseboards, cracks, door and window frames, and localized areas of the floor. (20)
