GENERAL DIRECTIONS: Thoroughly spray all cracks, crevices, cupboards, closets, around pipelines and fixtures baseboards, doors and windowsills and all areas where insects travel, breed or enter. Contact insects directly when they appear. Repeat as needed, or use about once a month to control recurrence.

ROACHES, ANTS, SILVERFISH, WATERBUGS - follow general directions. FLEAS - follow general directions and also spray the sleeping quarters of household pets, floors, and floor coverings. BEDBUGS - spray thoroughly beds, mattresses, closets, baseboards and bedding.

FOR FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, and certain other flying insects, close doors and windows and spray to fog area. Keep room closed for 10 to 15 minutes after treatment.

MOTHS & CARPET BEETLES - Treat so spray reaches every spot insects breed. Pay special attention to seams and folds in garments. Thoroughly spray interior of storage containers, as closets and trunks. Repeat treatments monthly unless treated articles are stored in a moth-tight container. Raise rugs where possible so spray will be forced through the fabric. Avoid wetting. Treat interior as well as outside of upholstered furniture. Apply thoroughly to infested areas of carpets & localized areas of floors and baseboards, and into cracks and under carpets, where carpet beetles may be found. Repeat as needed to maintain effective control.
