INGREDIENT STATEMENT

WEED-FREE ECB-4P is a granular non-selective weedkiller designed to be applied dry to the surface of the ground for control of weeds. The kill of weeds may be slow as the chemical is absorbed through roots of weeds and must be carried to root zone by moisture.

The degree of control and duration of effect will vary with the amount of chemical applied, soil type, rainfall, and other conditions.

DIRECTIONS

Before applying, measure area to be treated and select rate per acre desired to get amount needed for treatment. Calibrate over a small area and get even coverage with the rate/acre selected. A Seeder or Granular Herbicide Applicator may be used. 2 1/3 cups of WEED-FREE ECB-4P per 100 sq. ft. is approximately 400 lbs. broadcast per acre rate.

GENERAL WEED CONTROL

To control most weeds for an extended period of time on non-crop land such as Utility, Highway, Pipeline and Railroad Right of Way, Petroleum Tank Farms, Lumberyards, Storage Areas, Industrial Plant Sites, and around Farm Buildings, apply 60 to 120 lbs. per acre to control ANNUAL WEEDS and GRASSES such as foxtail, crabgrass, ragweed, and lambs'-quarters.

Apply 140 to 240 lbs. per acre to control PERENNIAL WEEDS and GRASSES such as Bahia grass, dogfennel, goldenrod, plantain, and wild carrot.

Apply 300 to 600 lbs. per acre to control HARD-TO-KILL PERENNIAL GRASSES such as JOHNSON-GRASS, BERMUDAGRASS, DALLISGRASS, NUT-GRASS, and VASEYGRASS.

Use the higher levels of the dosage rates on adsorptive soils (usually those high in organic matter or carbon). Make application of WEED-FREE ECB-4P just before or during the period of active growth of weeds.

CAUTION

Do not store with foodstuffs. Store in cool, dry place. Do not leave container where children or animals may take internally. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin and clothing. A-RID may be used for the control of most annual and perennial grasses, broad leafed weeds, and general weed control on non-crop land such as: right of ways, industrial plants, lumber yards, schools, storage and parking areas etc.

Best results will be attained if A-RID is applied shortly before or at the time plant growth begins. Water thoroughly after applying to move chemical to the root zone and speed up action. The effectiveness and length of time chemical will last, depends on type of soil, amount of rain, and other conditions.

CAUTION: Keep out of reach of children

DO NOT USE OR STORE NEAR HEAT OR OPEN FLAME. Harmful if swallowed. Irritating to skin and eyes. Do not get on skin, eyes or clothing. In case of contact, immediately wash with plenty of water; for eyes, flush with water for at least 15 minutes and get medical attention.

DIRECTIONS: For one acre (43,560 sq. ft.) mix 20 gals A-RID with 80 gals water and apply evenly throughout area. For very heavy vegetation, a second application should be made 10 days later. For smaller areas, use 6 oz. A-RID to one qt. water to treat 100 square feet.

Best results will be had if area is mowed and free of debris before applying A-RID. Apply in a coarse, wet spray to avoid drift.

NOTE: Do not apply, allow to drift, drain or flush onto or near croplands, lawns, trees or desirable plants, or to areas where their roots might extend. Do not contaminate water or irrigation ditches. Do not allow contact with seeds, fertilizers, insecticides or fungicides. Clean equipment with detergent and water after use to avoid corrosion. Do not use application equipment for insecticides, fertilizers or other agricultural chemicals, as any residue might injure plants.
