INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

SPOTRETE prevents the infestation of
common turf diseases such as Dollar
Spot, Brown Patch and Snow Mold if
sprayed at regular weekly intervals
throughout the summer season.

SPOTRETE will control Dollar Spot and
Brown Patch when applied at a higher
dosage to turf already infested with
these diseases.

Preventive Dosage:

A. For Dollar Spot and Brown Patch:
2½ ozs. per thousand square feet at
seven day intervals throughout the
warm season.

B. For Snow Mold: 8 ozs. per
thousand square feet late in the fall,
prior to snowfall.

Curative Dosage:

A. For Dollar Spot and Large Brown
Patch: 5 ozs. per thousand square feet
at seven day intervals.

Amount of Water

Use the amount necessary to obtain
uniform coverage. The actual amount is
not critical and will vary depending
upon type of sprayer used.
