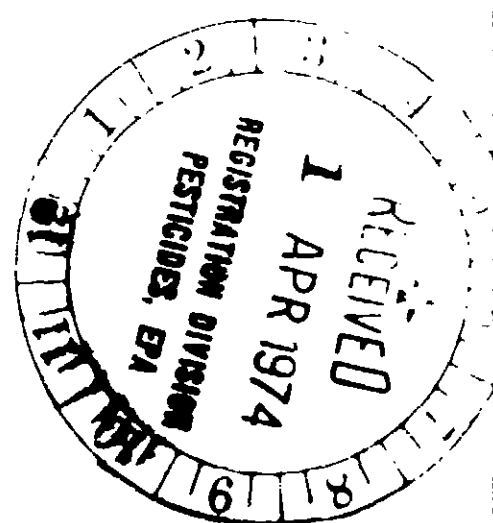
### DIRECTIONS FOR USE AS A SPRAY

DOLLAR SPOT CONTROL: Mix 6 ounces BROMOSAN in 5 to 10 gallons water and apply to 2,000 sq. ft. Applications should start early spring as a preventive and continued 7 to 10 day intervals during the disease season.

### OTHER DISEASES

During hot humid weather it may be necessary to increase the dosage to 6 oz. per 1500 sq. ft. to control other diseases such as Copper Spot, Brown Patch.

For the control of Helminthosporium (Leaf Spot) use the rate 6 oz. per 1000 sq. ft.
