 - b. The statement "Do not apply to snow covered turf" should appear in the directions for snow mold control for golf course fairways as well as for greens, tees, and ornamental turf.
 - c. Also, the second sentence following "Golf Course Fairways" would apply to the use on greens, tees, and ornamental turf. Add this sentence to the section on greens, tees, and ornamental turf.
 - o. Since a dosage range is included for snow mold control, add a general statement indicating when to use the high and low rates of the range.
 - e. Groundskeepers/turf maintenance personnel may not reenter treated areas within 24 hours following application unless chemical resistent gloves are worn.
