## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

### FACE FLIES

Spray PFIZER LIVESTOCK SPRAY on the face of cattle at the rate of 4 seconds per animal. Pay particular attention to spray the areas around the eyes and nostrils. Treatment should be made daily while the cattle are stanchioned for morning milking to give protection from face flies for 24 hours.

### HORSEFLIES & DEER FLIES

To protect livestock against horseflies and deer flies, spray each side of the animal (allowing 4 seconds spraying time per animal) paying particular attention to the back, flanks, and legs. For best protection during heavy infestation spray morning and evening.

### HORN FLIES & MOSQUITOES

To protect livestock against horn flies and mosquitoes spray each side of the animal (allowing 4 seconds per animal) paying particular attention to the back, flanks and legs for 4 seconds per animal. During periods of high infestation spray twice daily morning and evening; otherwise spray each morning.
