



DIRECTIONS

Backrubber units should be located where cattle congregate or loaf during the day — such as shady spots in the pasture, etc.

The cable against which the cattle rub can be made of burlap sacking wrapped around a core of barbed wire, chain, or wire rope. Variations of arrangements include a slack cable between two posts, two cables in the form of a "V" between three posts, or a taut cable set low on one post and high on the other. In either arrangement the sacking should be wrapped (about 4 inches thick) around the core and secured with ties (binder twine or cord) every 4 to 6 inches.

Dilute each gallon of Pfizer Cable Oil with 4 gallons of fuel oil or diesel fuel and mix thoroughly. Do not use crankcase oil or lubricating oil, both of which may be potentially harmful.

Apply the diluted solution (2% Malathion) on the

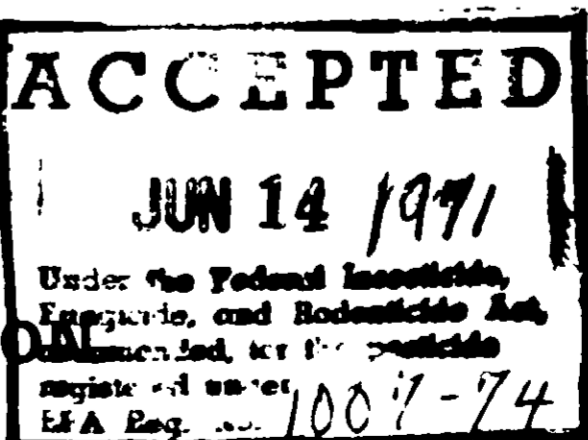
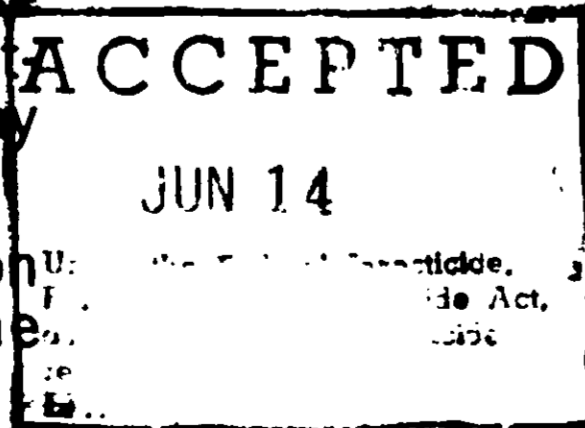

cable slowly to completely dampen it. Initial application will take approximately 1 gallon to 20 feet. Subsequent applications at approximately 2 week intervals will be required to keep the sacking properly moistened. About 2 quarts of diluted solution for each 20 feet of cable is sufficient for all applications except the first.

CAUTION: Avoid saturating the cable—too much oil is dangerous to cattle. Under no conditions should the oil solution be sprayed on animals. **Not to be used on dairy animals.** For protection of persons using this product: Avoid contact with skin. In case of skin contact, wash with soap and water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Harmful if swallowed. Atropine and 2-PAM are antidotal. Do not use or store near heat or open flame.
