Recommendation for disinfecting and deodorizing with Opie DC 6700 Disinfecting - Sanitizer - Deodorant Concentrate in Hospitals include hard surfaces, such as; floors, walls, ceilings, equipment and fixtures in areas such as; operating rooms, clinics, isolation wards, nurseries, diet kitchens, rest rooms, etc.

For disinfecting and deodorizing in schools and public institutions all hard surface areas, such as; corridors, class rooms, offices, rest rooms, locker rooms, showers - in public places where bacterial control is vital for protection of health.

For sanitizing and deodorizing food handling equipment in food, milk and beverage processing plants, restaurants and farms. Such equipment would include blanchers, evaporators, homogenizers, holding tanks, pipes, valves, fittings, utensils, etc. All equipment should be flushed with clear water just prior to use.

NOTE: This product fulfills the criteria of Appendix F of the Grade "A" Pasteurized Milk Ordinance 1965 Recommendations of the U.S. Public Health Service in waters up to 550 PPM (32 grains per gallon) of hardness calculated as Ca CO<sub>3</sub> when tested by the method outlined by Chambers. If there is a question as to the effectiveness of the product in your area, the recommendation of your local health department should be followed.

In use dilutions Opie DC 6700 Disinfecting - Sanitizer - Deodorant Concentrate is non-corrosive.

## DIRECTIONS

For floors, walls and other hard surfaces in Hospitals, Institutions, Public Rooms, Homes, Industrial Areas, Conveyances, etc.

## DISINFECTING

To previously cleaned surfaces, apply by mop or cloth or flood surface with solution of one (1) ounce of Opie DC 6700 Concentrate to two (2) gallons of water.

In instances, i. e., operating rooms where surfaces may be heavily contaminated, use one (1) ounce Opie DC 6700 Concentrate to one (1) gallon of water. For maximum germicidal activity surfaces should be wet thoroughly.

## SANITIZING

To previously cleaned surfaces, apply by mop or cloth or flood surfaces with solution containing one (1) ounce Opie DC 6700 Concentrate to four (4) gallons of water. Allow at least two (2) minutes of contact with surface before rinsing. Milk cans and other equipment should be air-dried instead of rinsed. Then flush with clear water just prior to use.

## DEODORIZING

Apply to previously cleaned surfaces by mop, cloth or flood surface with solution containing one (1) ounce of Opie DC 6700 Concentrate to one (1) gallon of water.

## CAUTION
