Directions for Use

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DC-7128 is a proven "one-step" cleaner - disinfectant - sanitizer - fungicide - mildewstat - virucide in the presence of moderate amounts of organic soil.

Apply **DC-7128** to walls, floors and other hard (inanimate) non-porous surfaces such as tables, chairs, countertops, tile, porcelain, sinks and bedframes with a cloth, mop or mechanical spray device so as to thoroughly wet surfaces. For heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning is required. Prepare a fresh solution daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty.

Disinfection - To disinfect hard, non-porous surfaces, add 1 oz per gallon of water. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. The activity of **DC-7128** has been evaluated in the presence of 5% serum by the AOAC use dilution test and found to be effective against a broad spectrum of gram negative and gram positive organisms as represented by:

Fungicide Performance

DC-7128 is an effective fungicide against Trichophyton mentagrophytes (the athlete's foot fungus) when used on surfaces in areas such as locker rooms, dressing rooms, shower and bath areas, exercise facilities, etc. at 1 oz. per gallon.

Mold and Mildew Control

Effectively inhibit the growth of mold and mildew and the odors caused by them when applied to hard, non-porous surfaces (as indicated in general instructions above). Allow to dry on surface and repeat when mildew growth returns.

Virucidal Performance

DC-7128 was evaluated in the presence of 15% serum and found to be effective against the following viruses: Influenza A, B, C, Herpes Simplex and Vaccinia on inanimate environmental surfaces.

Sanitizing Non-Food Contact Surfaces (such as floors, walls, tables, etc.) At 1 oz. per 3.5 gallon use-level **DC-7128** is an effective sanitizer against *Staphylococcus aureus* and *Klebsiella pneumoniae* in the presence of 5% serum on porous and non-porous environmental surfaces.
