PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
Statement of Practical Treatment

IF SWALLOWED: Do not induce vomiting. Call a Physician or Poison Control Center immediately.

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing spray mist. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wash skin thoroughly after handling. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Wear long pants, long sleeved shirt and shoes when applying. Do not allow children or pets into treated area until spray has dried. Do not reenter treated area until spray has dried.

Environmental Hazards
Malathion is toxic to fish. Use with care when applying in areas adjacent to any body of water. Keep out of lakes, streams and ponds. Do not apply directly to water. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from target area. Shrimp and crab may be killed at application rates recommended on this label. Do not apply where these are important resources. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

Malathion is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or to residues remaining on the treated area. Do not apply when bees are actively visiting the crop, cover crop or weeds blooming in the treated area. Applications should be timed to provide the maximum possible interval between treatment and the next period of bee activity.

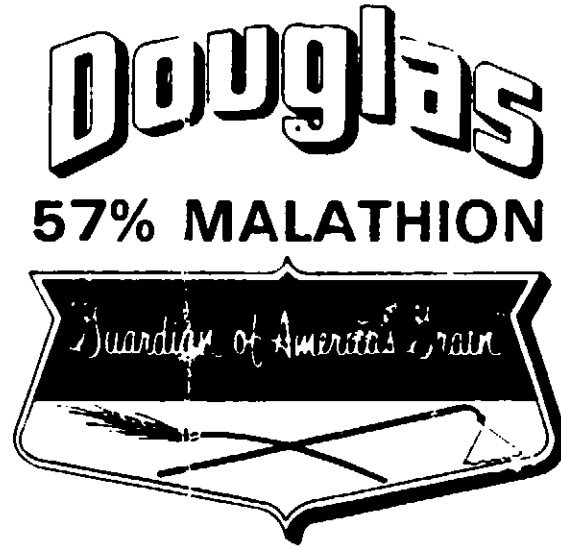
DIRECTIONS FOR USE
It is a violation of FEDERAL LAW to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

REENTRY STATEMENT

Do not enter treated areas without protective clothing until sprays have dried. Protective clothing consists of long-sleeved shirt, long pants, gloves, hat and shoes.

Because certain states may require more restrictive reentry intervals for various crops treated with this product, consult your State Department of Agriculture for further information.

Written or oral warnings must be given to workers who are expected to be in a treated area or in an area about to be treated with this product. All workers not directly involved with the application of this product must be removed from the area to be treated. All other workers must be informed of the area which is to be treated and informed not to enter the area until such time as the spray has dried without the proper protective clothing listed above. In the event a worker is exposed to this product he should inform his supervisor immediately of the type of exposure in order that proper protective treatment may be given. When oral warnings are given, warnings shall be given in a language customarily understood by workers. Oral warnings must be given if there is reason to believe that written warnings cannot be understood by workers. Written warnings must include the following information: "CAUTION: Area treated with malathion on (insert date of treatment). Do not enter without appropriate protective clothing until spray has dried. In case of accidental exposure inform supervisor immediately."

Storage
