The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act as amended is acceptable, provided you make the following changes before you release the product for shipment.

Please note that the following changes only apply to the Dichlobenil 50W part of the subpack.

1. It is recommended that the complete company address and phone number be added to the label.
2. Add EPA Registration Number and establishment number to dichlobenil package label.
3. Update First Aid Statement to comply with PR Notice 2001-1 as follows:

**FIRST AID**

**IF SWALLOWED:**

- Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice
- Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow
- Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor
- Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person

**IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:**

- Take off contaminated clothing.
- Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes
- Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice

**IF IN EYES:**

- Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes
- Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first five minutes, then continue rinsing eye
- Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice

**IF INHALED:**

- Move person to fresh air.
- If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible
- Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice


4. Place FIRST AID STATEMENTS in a box format. See PR Notice 2001-1.
5. Add the following hotline information under FIRST AID statements  
"For additional information in case of emergency call toll free (1-800-XXX-XXXX). Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor for treatment."
6. Remove current Precautionary Statements and change to the following:  
"Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing"
7. Add the following Ground Water Advisory:  
"This chemical has properties and characteristics associated with chemicals detected in ground water. The use of this chemical in areas where soils are permeable, particularly where the water table is shallow may result in ground-water contamination."
8. Add a section called Personal Protective Equipment, with the following information:  
Mixers, loaders, applicators and other handlers must wear:
  - Long sleeved shirt and long pants
  - Shoes plus socks
  - Chemical resistant gloves made of any waterproof material
  - Chemical resistant apron when mixing and loading
9. Add a section called User Safety Requirements, with the following information:  
"Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washable, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry."
10. Add a section called User Safety Recommendations, with the following information:  
"Users should:  
Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet.  
Remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing.  
Remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing.  
As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing."
11. Change "Storage" to "Pesticide Storage" under STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
12. Change "Disposal" to "Pesticide Disposal" under STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
13. Change "Plastic Bags" to "Container Disposal: Plastic Bag"

14. Add the following restriction:

"When used in inhabited buildings (residences, offices, hospitals, etc.,) windows must be open or an exhaust fan must be operating during the application"

Submit three (3) copies of final printed labeling incorporating the above changes before you release the product for shipment. Amended labeling will supercede all previously accepted ones. A stamped copy of labeling is enclosed for your records.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

- IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Get medical attention.
- IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water.
- IF SWALLOWED: Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
- IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician if irritation persists.

STORAGE: Do not store near food or feed, seeds, bulbs, tubers, nursery stock or other vegetative matter. Do not store near pet or livestock quarters. Store in a cool, dry, and well ventilated area. Do not open this protective outer tube until water soluble bags are needed.

DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site by discharging into sewer pipes being treated or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Plastic Bags: Remove both water soluble bags from the outer protective plastic tube before use in application equipment. Then dispose of empty outer tube in a sanitary landfill or by incineration or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
