CHECKS SCRATCHING DUE TO BITES OF FLEAS, TICKS, LICE

FLEAS, LICE AND TICKS ON DOGS: Dust the animal thoroughly with Flea and Tick Powder. Cover entire body including legs and feet. Rub hair with comb or hand to make sure powder reaches the skin. Repeat treatment once a week for best results.

TICKS IN KENNEL: Dust freely in and around the animal's bed, into cracks and crevices.

KILLS FLEAS TICKS AND LICE ON DOGS

CAUTION

Avoid inhalation, contact with skin and eyes, and contamination of foodstuffs. Use only on dogs and premises as directed. May be absorbed through skin. Wash hands with soap and water after handling or applying to animals. Keep away from children; harmful if swallowed.

Do not apply to nursing mother or nursing puppies. Do not use on sick or convalescing animals. Place fresh bedding in animal quarter after treatment.

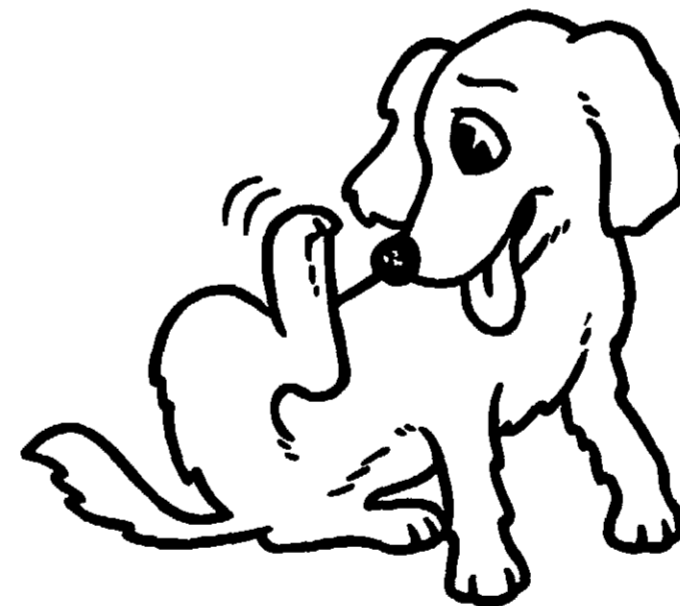
