The following amendment submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below.

Revise the label as follows:

- 1) Under "General Disinfection," add the following statements, "*When used in Food and Bottling Processing Plants, food products and packaging materials must be removed from room or carefully protected. A potable rinse is required.*"
- 2) Under "Sanitizing Food Eggs," revise the 2nd, 5th, and 6th statements by deleting the term, "should," and stating "*must*" such that the directions are in compliance with PR Notice 2000-5, Mandatory Labeling

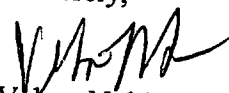
A stamped copy of the labeling accepted with conditions is enclosed. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed label before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.

AREAS OF USE: Oakite Sanitizer 1 is designed for use in food processing plants, milk plants, egg product processing plants, etc. The order of cleanliness must be maintained.

DIRECTIONS: Thoroughly clean and rinse surfaces before applying germicidal treatment. Prepare a fresh solution.

GENERAL DISINFECTION (Not for use on animate surfaces): Mix 1 fl. oz. per gallon of water. Apply with a mop, brush, cloth or sponge. Treated surfaces should be visible. For Heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning is recommended. Surfaces become visibly soiled or dirty.

MOLD AND MILDEW CONTROL: For general use use 1 oz. per 1 gallon of water, mold and mildew odors caused by them on hard nonporous surfaces. Repeat every 7 days or more often when needed.

FOOD CONTACT SANITIZING: For sanitizing food contact equipment, food utensils, dishes, silverware, etc., use 1 fl. oz. per gallon of water. Rinse equipment, and other food contact hard nonporous surfaces and soil by pre-flush, pre-scrape, and when necessary, use a good detergent or compatible cleaner before sanitizing. Apply use solution of 1/2 oz. per 4 gallons of water, thoroughly wetting surfaces with solution. Surfaces should remain wet for 60 seconds (one minute). Drain and air dry before reuse. Prepare a fresh solution if soiled.

② **SANITIZING FOOD EGGS:** To sanitize processing plants, spray with 1 1/4 ounce solution. The solution should be warmer than the eggs. Eggs sanitized with this product shall be immediately broken for use in the manufacturing process. The solution should not be used for casing or breaking. The solution should not be used for casing or breaking. This product fulfills the criteria of Approved Disinfectants of the U.S. Public Health Service. CaCO₃, when tested by the A.O.A.C. Germicidal.

TO CONTROL SLIME IN RECIRCULATING SYSTEMS: Initial Application: When the system is cleaned, apply 1 ppm of solution per 1000 gallons of water in the system where it will be mixed uniformly and cleaned manually.

Subsequent dose: When control of microorganisms is present, the system must be cleaned manually. The dosage is 1 ppm of solution per 1000 gallons of water in the system. This application must be repeated if bleed-off and severity of the algae problem is present, the system must be cleaned manually.

DIARY FARMS, MILK PLANTS: For sanitizing separators, sanitary piping, coolers, pasteurizers, etc., use 1 fl. oz. per gallon of water. Apply with solution of Oakite Sanitizer 1. Apply concentration of 1/4 fluid oz. at 2 gallons of water to 4 gallons of water, which approximates 1 ppm of solution.
