Flush toilet. Add 1 1/2 fluid oz (3 tablespoons) directly to water in toilet bowl (3/4 gallon). Brush to cover all bowl surfaces including under the rim. Treated surface must remain wet for ten minutes. Flush toilet.

For heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning may be required.  
For badly stained bowls, repeat above treatment using 60-120 ml (2-4 fl oz) OAKITE PROLINE PERFORM.
