DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Dilute one part of PYROCIDE BOOSTER CONCENTRATE E with 19 parts of deodorized base oil to prepare a powerful roach spray for use in cafes and restaurants, food storage warehouses, food processing plants and flour mills.

To kill roaches, silverfish, waterbugs, ants, crickets and sowbugs: Apply the diluted spray with a sprayer that gives large, wetting droplets to cracks and crevices in walls and floors, areas behind shelving and machinery, cracks about floor drains, behind pipes and other places where these insects harbor. Contact directly as many insects as possible. Repeat applications as necessary.

CAUTION KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Harmful if swallowed. Cover or remove food and feedstuffs during spraying. In food processing plants, do not spray while processing is underway. After spraying in food processing plants, etc., wash with potable water all equipment, benches, shelving and surfaces where exposed food will be handled. Do not remain in treated areas if closed. Ventilate area after treatment is complete.

This intermediate is toxic to fish and other aquatic animals. Do not contaminate any body of water with equipment cleaning solutions, spillage or wastage.

Do not re-use drum. Dispose of drum through commercial reconditioning service or by perforation or crushing and burying in a safe place.

Mix well in drum before sampling and each use. Keep container closed. Store in a cool place. Do not store, pour or spill near heat or open flame.
