DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To be diluted with water to make a dip for produce, preliminary to washing and processing.

Dilute with hard or soft water, preferably warmed to 60°F. Do not use stronger than one part of MGK Insect Loosener to 3,300 parts of water (one pound makes 400 gallons of dip). For corn borers on sweet corn, use one part of MGK Insect Loosener to 5,000 parts of water (one pound makes 600 gallons of dip). Make each solution fresh daily. Additional wetting agent such as Dreft or Vel may be used if desired. After immersion of the produce in the solution make sure it is not washed again for a period of three to eight minutes. Then wash the large volumes of clear water to remove insects and dirt.

CAUTION

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Harmful if swallowed. Do not use concentrations strong enough to kill insects on the plants. Use only enough to agitate them so as to insure their removal by succeeding washes.

This product is toxic to fish. Do not contaminate any body of water with spillage, wastage, or equipment cleaning solutions.

Do not re-use empty drum. Dispose of drum through commercial drum reconditioning service, or destroy by perforation or crushing and burying in a safe place.

Do not pour or spill near open flame. Store in a cool dry place. Keep container closed. Mix well in drum before sampling and each use.
