DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Brush woolen articles clean, air, remove persistent spots and stains by dry-cleaning. For best protection, clean and spray insides of closets or storage units for 30-40 seconds before putting away treated articles. Treatment should be repeated every thirty days.
