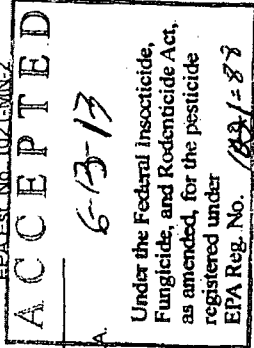

Post harvest sprays to food crops; 6.) Food producing animals or fowl (direct application to meat and dairy animals or their premises when occupied); 7.) Dust for use in power dusters or for use on pets.

Formulators who use this product may be responsible for providing data to support their own registrations with the appropriate regulatory agencies.
