In order to maintain consistency with many other MGK products, you must revise the 2<sup>nd</sup> sentence within the "HOTLINE NUMBER" subsection to read "For additional information on this pesticide product (including health concerns, medical emergencies, or pesticide concerns), you may call 1-888-740-8712."

Precautionary Statements, Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals subsection comment(s):

2. Revise the 5<sup>th</sup> sentence within this subsection to read "Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling, and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet."

Precautionary Statements, Environmental Hazards subsection comment(s):

3. In order to maintain consistency with many other MGK products, you must revise the subsection heading "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARD" to read "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS."

Storage and Disposal section comment(s):



To facilitate inclusion of required label language from PR Notice 2007-4, you must revise the "PESTICIDE STORAGE:" subsection to read "PESTICIDE STORAGE: Keep this product in its tightly closed original container when not in use. Please submit two (2) copies of the final printed labeling, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with section 6(e) of FIFRA. This product may not be used to formulate products for the following uses: 1.) Terrestrial food and non-food crops. 2.) Aquatic uses. 3.) Greenhouse Food Crops. 4.) Forestry uses. 5.) Post harvest sprays to food crops. 6.) Food producing animals or fowl (direct application to meat and dairy animals or their premises when occupied).

Formulators who use this product may be responsible for providing data to support their own registrations with the appropriate regulatory agencies.
