FOR MANUFACTURING USE ONLY

Use 15 parts of PYROCIDE® AEROSOL MIX NO. 5198 with 85 parts by weight of propellant (50/50 mix of propellents 11 and 12) in an aerosol dispenser for use in the control of flying insects.

CAUTION

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid skin contact. In case of skin contact wash with soap and water. Do not breathe fumes or spray mist. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.
